	End of motorway Motorway sign. Marks the end of the motorway; motorway regulations (no learner drivers, no pedestrians/cyclist...		Crossroads Yellow diamond warning sign (cross symbol). Crossroads ahead where the crossing road is of equal importance — ...
	T-junction Yellow diamond warning sign. T-junction ahead — the road you are on ends at a junction; you must turn left or ...		Y-junction Yellow diamond warning sign. Y-junction ahead — the road divides or another road forks off at a shallow angle....
	Staggered crossroads Yellow diamond warning sign. Staggered junction ahead — side roads join from opposite sides but are offset, no...		Crossroads on a dual carriageway Yellow diamond warning sign. Crossroads ahead where your road crosses a dual carriageway — cross in two stages...
